MOCK YOUTH PARLIAMENT

'Model United Nations' (MUN) Club of Sathchidanada Jothi Nikethan International School, Kallar organised a two-day workshop on the 12th and 13th of August for the members. The Model United Nations is also known as model UN or MUN is an educational model of the United Nations used for simulations in which students learn about diplomacy and international relations. At Satchidananda MUN mastery programme was conducted by Mr.Mohammed Yasir Arfath from the Indian Conclave, an organisation that engages in conducting activities such as MUN conferences etc., This workshop was meant to acquaint the new club members of the academic year 2024-25 with the knowledge and techniques necessary to succeed beyond the typical MUN experience. An extensive analysis of the United Nations' framework, including its main elements, functions, and protocols, was given on the first day of the workshop. Members were engaged in the MUN simulation to practice their skills in exercising diplomatic negotiations.



On the second day, the club organized its first 'Youth Parliament', a simulation of the Lok Sabha focused on the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP). This involved in-depth policy discussions, committee formations, and resolution drafting. The audience was shown a video on "The Features of the Parliament of India" to gain a better knowledge of the Lok Sabha's operations prior to the mock session.



The youth parliament was presided over by Dr. Kavidasan, the Secretary of the school. In his address to the students, he emphasized the value of communication in the current situation and urged everyone in attendance to participate in many clubs the school offers in order to develop their personalities and become qualified to be global citizens. He also reviewed the participants' feedback from the workshop and acknowledged the best performance made by them.

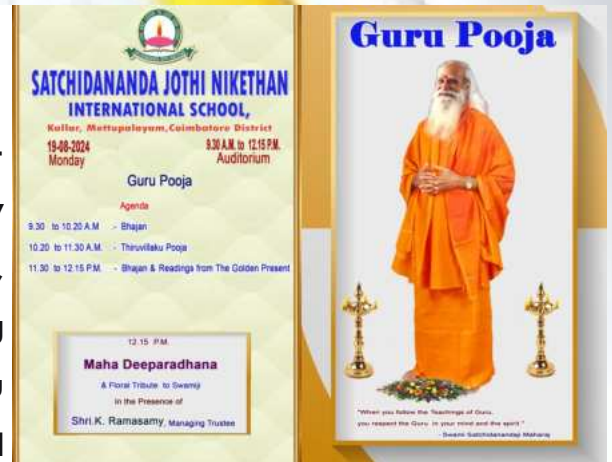
Guru Pooja
